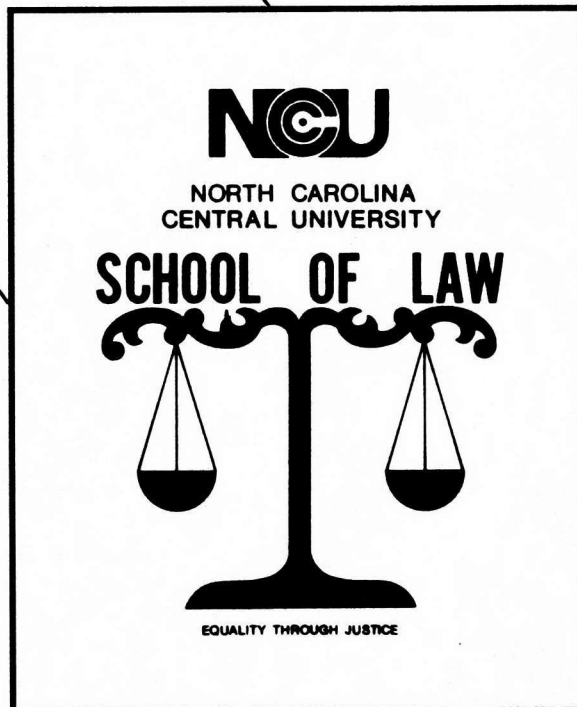

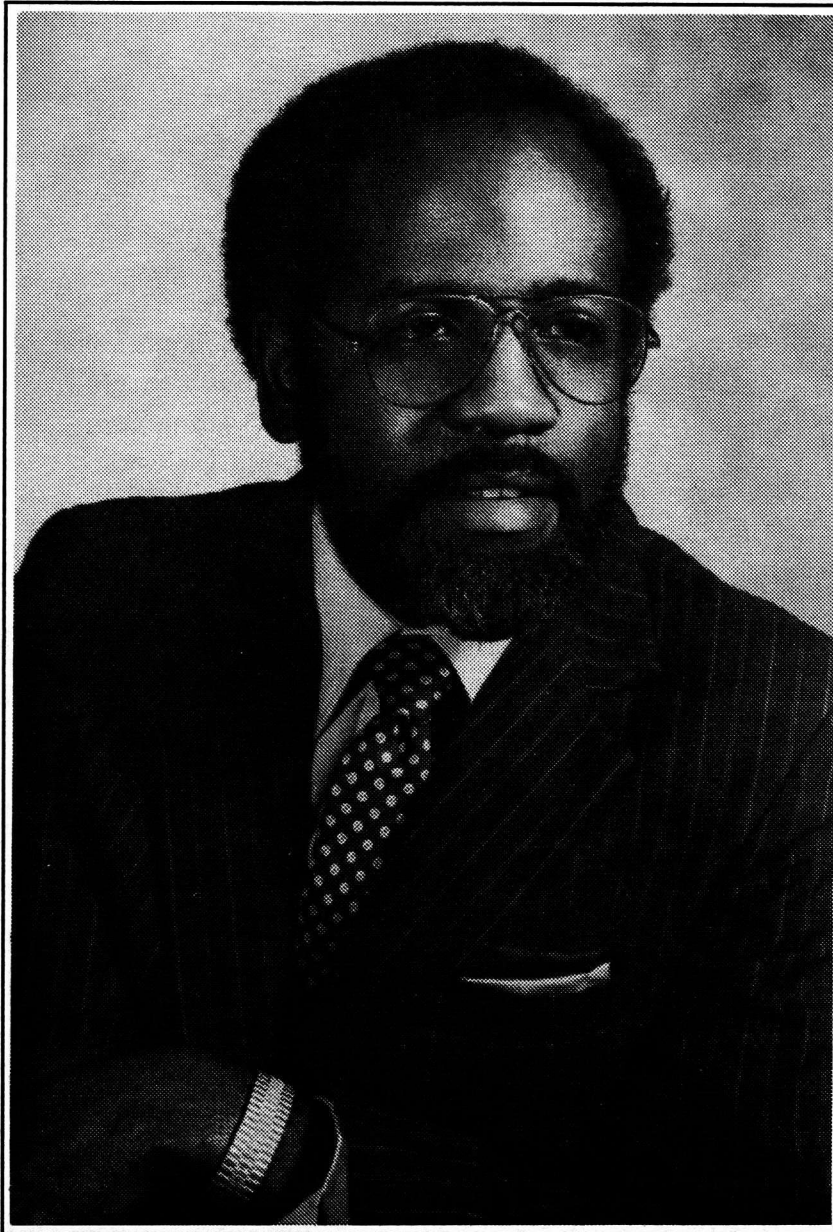

Mr. Holloway is listed in *Who's Who in American Law* and he is a recipient of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Award.
