At the June 6, 1992, Alumni Association Board of Directors meeting, I became a Bronze Eagle for this coming fiscal year by giving \$1,000 toward our Annual Fund Drive and to the goals for this year. 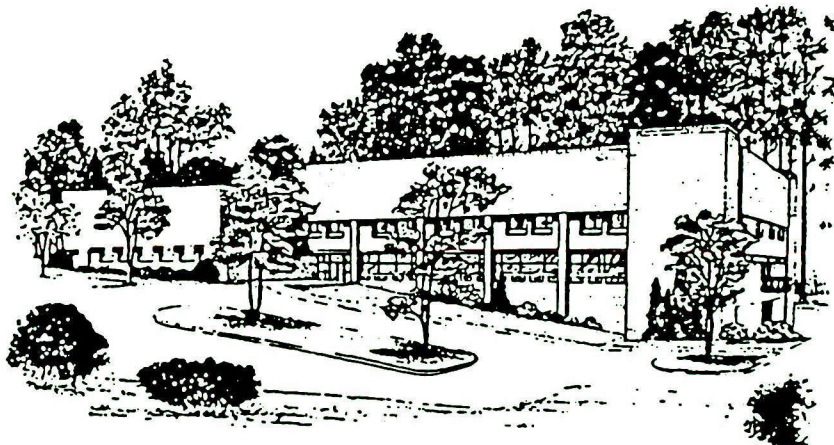
