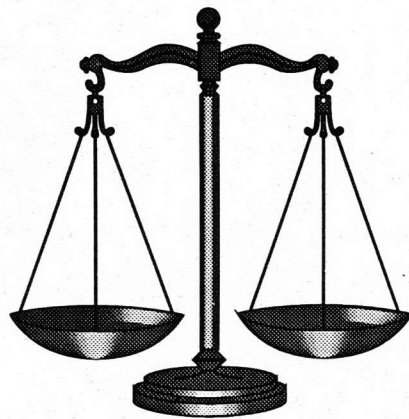

I take great pride in recommending these talented, impressive and dedicated North Carolina Central University School of Law students for summer and permanent employment.

North Carolina Central University School of Law has chosen to remain a small school and is very selective in its admissions. We offer admission to roughly 250 of 1700 applicants to register an entering class of 90 students in the Day Program and 30 students in the Evening Program.

Our students acquire the "fundamental skills and values" necessary to practice law effectively and are committed to serving their communities and the legal profession. They participate in our clinical programs and compete on client counseling, trial advocacy and moot court teams.

In writing this letter of recommendation, I am compelled to become a strong advocate for this law school. Despite a litany of accomplishments and outstanding graduates, the North Carolina Central University School of Law must defend its existence against individuals and institutions that seek to openly or covertly belittle the achievements of its graduates solely because the School of Law is an historically black institution.

First, graduates of the School of Law have become a state supreme court justice in Connecticut, a three-time mayor of Atlanta, the Attorney General of North Carolina, and a corporate president. Willie E. Gary, one of the nation's outstanding trial attorneys, is a graduate of the School of Law.

The 1996 Princeton Review of the Best Law Schools' demand index rates the School of Law fourth behind Harvard, Stanford and Yale because the School of Law receives so many applications and admits so few students. Over the last two years the Princeton Review has ranked the School of Law second and fourth in the nation for the percentage of its graduates employed in public interest positions after graduation.

During the 1994-95 academic year, the Trial Advocacy team reached the "final four" of the 64 law schools entering teams in the Association of Trial Lawyers of America National Competition. The NCCU team defeated teams from the University of North Carolina, University of Maryland, Howard University, University of Texas, University of Alabama and University of Florida.

In 1995, the National Jurist Magazine named the North Carolina Central University School of Law the best law school for women. Repeated successes despite historical discrimination in funding and hiring of graduates deserve support rather than dismissal or avoidance. We urge you to look favorably on job applicants from the North Carolina Central University School of Law.

## THE SCHOOL OF LAW

### GENERAL

North Carolina Central University (NCCU) was chartered in 1909 as a private institution and opened to students in July of 1910. In 1923, when the General Assembly of North Carolina appropriated funds for the purchase and maintenance of the school, the institution became the first state supported liberal arts college for blacks in the United States. In July 1972, NCCU became one of the constituent institutions of the University of North Carolina system.

Fifty-four buildings are located on the 105 acre campus in the heart of Durham, North Carolina, a city of more than 100,000 residents. NCCU has evolved into a multi-purpose urban university with a cosmopolitan student body and more than 300 persons on the instructional faculty.

Of a total enrollment of approximately 5,000 students, approximately 950 are enrolled in the graduate and professional schools. Approximately 600 students come from out of state; 60 percent are women; 22 percent are part-time students.

The North Carolina Central University School of Law was established in 1939. The school has been accredited by the American Bar Association since 1950.

### BASIC PROGRAM OF STUDY AND DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The Day Program requires three academic years of full-time study for the Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree and the successful completion of a minimum of 88 semester hours of required and elective courses with a minimum cumulative average of 2.0. The year is divided into two equal semesters. The Day Program is designed for full-time students and requires substantially all of the student's time during the academic year.

In the first year, students take 31 semester hours of required courses (property, torts, criminal law, civil procedure, contracts, and legal methods) and an intensive writing class. The second year curriculum offers the student a range of core courses which build upon the first year foundation and provides the educational depth and breadth expected of a well rounded legal professional. The third year curriculum offers a variety of electives as well as clinical courses.

Legal research and writing are essential components of the entire educational program. All students participate in the appellate moot court program which requires the preparation of legal briefs and oral arguments. All students must satisfy a writing requirement for graduation by undertaking a supervised research and writing project.

The Evening Program operates throughout the year, including two five week summer sessions. Students in this program can complete academic work for the J.D. degree in four calendar years by going to school year round. Eligibility requirements for graduation are substantially the same as for the Day Program.

## **SPECIAL PROGRAMS**

The Clinical Program consists of courses in evidence and trial practice with mock trials and oral arguments involving outstanding trial lawyers, appellate lawyers and jurists. Third year students represent indigent clients in civil matters and misdemeanor criminal cases under the supervision of practicing attorneys and faculty members.

It is not an unusual experience to walk into a courtroom in Durham or Raleigh and find one of our law students trying a case. The Clinical Program operates during the school year and summer months.

## **LAW LIBRARY AND PHYSICAL FACILITIES**

The School of Law is located in the Albert L. Turner Building, a handsome four story, 73,000 square foot brick building. This modern facility provides an ideal physical environment for the study of law and enhances classroom exchange between professors and students.

The law library contains over 110,000 volumes of up-to-date research and educational materials. An aggressive acquisition program is in progress. Individual carrels, meeting rooms, computer terminals, and well furnished study areas provide an excellent atmosphere for academic pursuits.

## **ACTIVITIES**

The *North Carolina Central Law Journal*, published semi-annually, is devoted to articles by legal scholars and to case notes and comments by students. Invitations to join the *Law Journal* are extended to students on the basis of academic achievement in their first year of law school. A writing competition in the fall semester permits second and third year students to compete for membership on the *Law Journal*.

The School of Law has a complete moot court and trial advocacy program. Intra - and interscholastic competitions provide students with an opportunity to write appellate briefs, participate in mock trials and appellate oral arguments, and counsel clients.

Student organizations at the School of Law include the Student Bar Association, Moot Court Board, American Bar Association/Law Student Division, Black Law Student Association, Women's Caucus, and Law Day Committee, Future Attorneys Challenging Elementary Students and National Lawyers Guild. There are chapters of three legal fraternities: Delta Theta Phi, Phi Alpha Delta and Phi Delta Phi.

## **ADMISSIONS**

The School of Law welcomes students of all races to contribute to its diversity while continuing to pursue with vigor its historic mission of producing a substantial percentage of minority attorneys for the state and nation. The school gives considerable weight to the traditional criteria of the LSAT score and UGPA, but it also considers evidence that an applicant, who might be of doubtful admissibility on those factors alone, has demonstrated in other ways a likelihood of succeeding in the legal profession.



The School of Law seeks students who are more likely to contribute affirmatively to the learning of others by reason of their intellectual attainments, demonstrated emotional maturity and self-discipline, oral ability, social background, or exceptional capacity to benefit from the school's educational program.

For this reason, applicants are asked to provide full information about their intellectual attainments, their personal achievements, employment experience, and social background.

### **FACULTY**

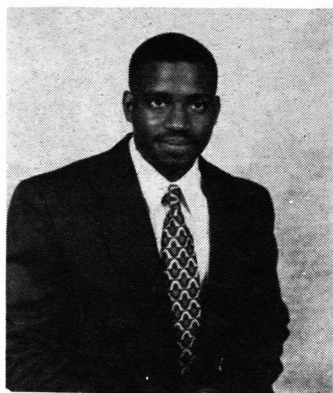
The School of Law has eighteen full-time faculty members and administrators. Faculty members earned their law degrees from the following institutions: Catholic U.; U. of Chicago; Cornell U.; Duke U.; Georgetown U.; George Washington U.; Harvard U.; UNC-Chapel Hill; North Carolina Central U.; Rutgers U.; and U. of Pennsylvania. Five faculty members hold advanced law degrees from Columbia U., Duke U., U. of Florida, or Harvard U. The faculty is composed of 11 African-American, 7 white, 10 male, and 8 female members and administrators.

### **STUDENTS**

The approximate enrollment is 321: 50 percent African-American; 50 percent White and other minorities; 55 percent female; and 85 to 90 percent North Carolinian.

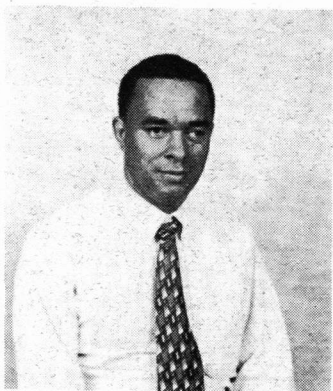
