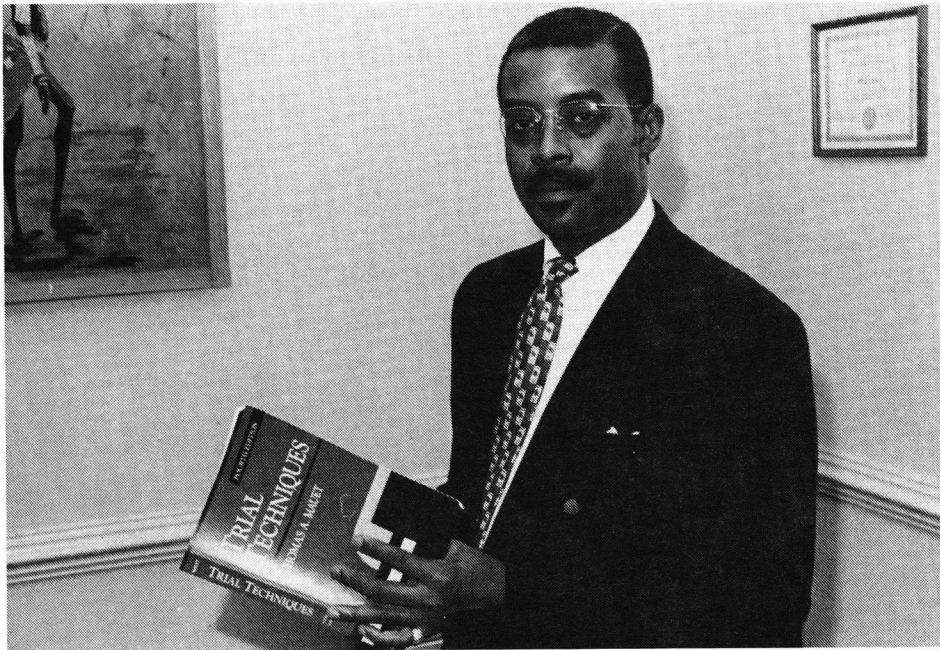

## **NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF LAW: EXCELLENCE IN TRIAL ADVOCACY - IT IS NOT A QUESTION OF 'CAN', BUT A QUESTION OF 'WILL'!**

*"The outstanding record of accomplishment compiled by the Trial Advocacy Board since 1994 has firmly established NCCU's trial program as one of the best in the nation. The challenge for the future is to retain the current ranking and continue to strive to become the very best of the best."* Grady Jessup, Faculty Advisor, Trial Advocacy Board.

The Trial Advocacy Board of North Carolina Central University School of Law has gained regional and national recognition for its excellence in trial advocacy since its reorganization in the Fall of 1993. Trial teams sponsored by the Trial Advocacy Board have either advanced to the final rounds of competitions or have won the regional competitions of seven consecutive trial competitions against trial teams from other law schools. "The success of the Trial Advocacy Board in such a relatively short period of time has exceeded our expectations", said Professor Grady Jessup, the faculty advisor to the Trial Advocacy Board.

In the Fall of 1993, Professor Jessup joined the faculty of the Law School as a Visiting Professor after practicing for seven years as a trial lawyer in Charlotte, North Carolina. When Grady Jessup was a student at North Carolina Central University School of Law, he participated as a member of both the Moot Court Board and the Trial Advocacy Board. When he returned to the Law School as a Visiting Professor, he and Professor Thomas Ringer spearheaded the effort to revitalize the Trial Advocacy Board, which had been dormant since 1986. A meeting of interested students was held in the Fall of 1993. In the Spring of 1994, trial teams were sent to the Regional Competition sponsored by the National Trial Competition in Arkansas and to the Regional Competition sponsored by the Association of Trial Lawyers of America in Raleigh, North Carolina. Trial teams compete in simulated criminal or civil trials against trial teams from other law schools and their performances are evaluated by a panel of practicing attorneys and judges.

According to Professor Ringer, "even though the initial teams did not advance beyond the preliminary rounds of those competitions, we learned that members of the student body had a strong interest in trial advocacy and that there are a substantial number of talented trial advocates among members of the student body at this Law School." From 1994 through 1997, trial teams from Central have participated annually in the National Trial Competition and in the Association of Trial Lawyers of America Competition. In addition, a trial team from Central participated in a trial competition sponsored by the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers in Houston, Texas, in the Fall of 1994 and another trial team participated in the Southeastern Trial Competition in Atlanta, Georgia, in November of 1996. Over the past three and a half years, trial teams from Central have competed against and defeated teams from the following law schools: George Washington University, Brigham Young University, the University of South Carolina, Campbell University, Memphis State University, the University of Richmond, Howard University, the University of Maryland, the University of Missouri at St. Louis, the University of Florida, the University of Alabama, the University of Texas, the University of North Carolina, the University of Tennessee, the College of William and Mary, the University of

Baltimore, Georgetown University Law Center, the University of Houston, Georgia State University, the University of Georgia, Florida State University, the Mississippi College of Law, the University of Arkansas, the University of Mississippi, Southwest Texas University and the University of San Diego.

At the present time, the Trial Advocacy Board has a membership of approximately ninety (90) students. One of the goals of the Trial Advocacy Board is to provide an opportunity for law students to develop and enhance their trial advocacy skills. In addition to sponsoring trial teams in regional and national competitions, the Board also sponsors three in-house competitions among law school students: The Dean Mary Wright First-Year Law Student Competition; the Attorney General Michael Easley Second-Year Law Student Competition and the Attorney Willie Gary Third-Year Law Student Competition. More than one-hundred law school students have participated in these competitions. The following students have won the intra-school competitions since 1994.

In the Spring of 1997, trial teams from Central won regional competitions in both the National Trial Competition and the Association of Trial Lawyers of America Competition. Consequently, both teams advanced to the national championships of those respective trial competitions. This is the first time that Central has placed teams in the national championships of both of the major law school trial advocacy competitions. To quote Dean Percy Luney, "the Trial Advocacy teams from North Carolina Central University School of Law have reached the mountaintop and are bringing regional and national recognition to this Law School."

The success that the Trial Advocacy Board has enjoyed is based on the legal knowledge, skills and dedication of the students who have participated on the trial teams as well as the excellent coaching and trial advocacy expertise of Professor Jessup. The members of the Trial Advocacy Board appreciate the financial and moral support provided by the Student Bar Association, the members of the student body and the Law School Administration, faculty, staff and alumni.

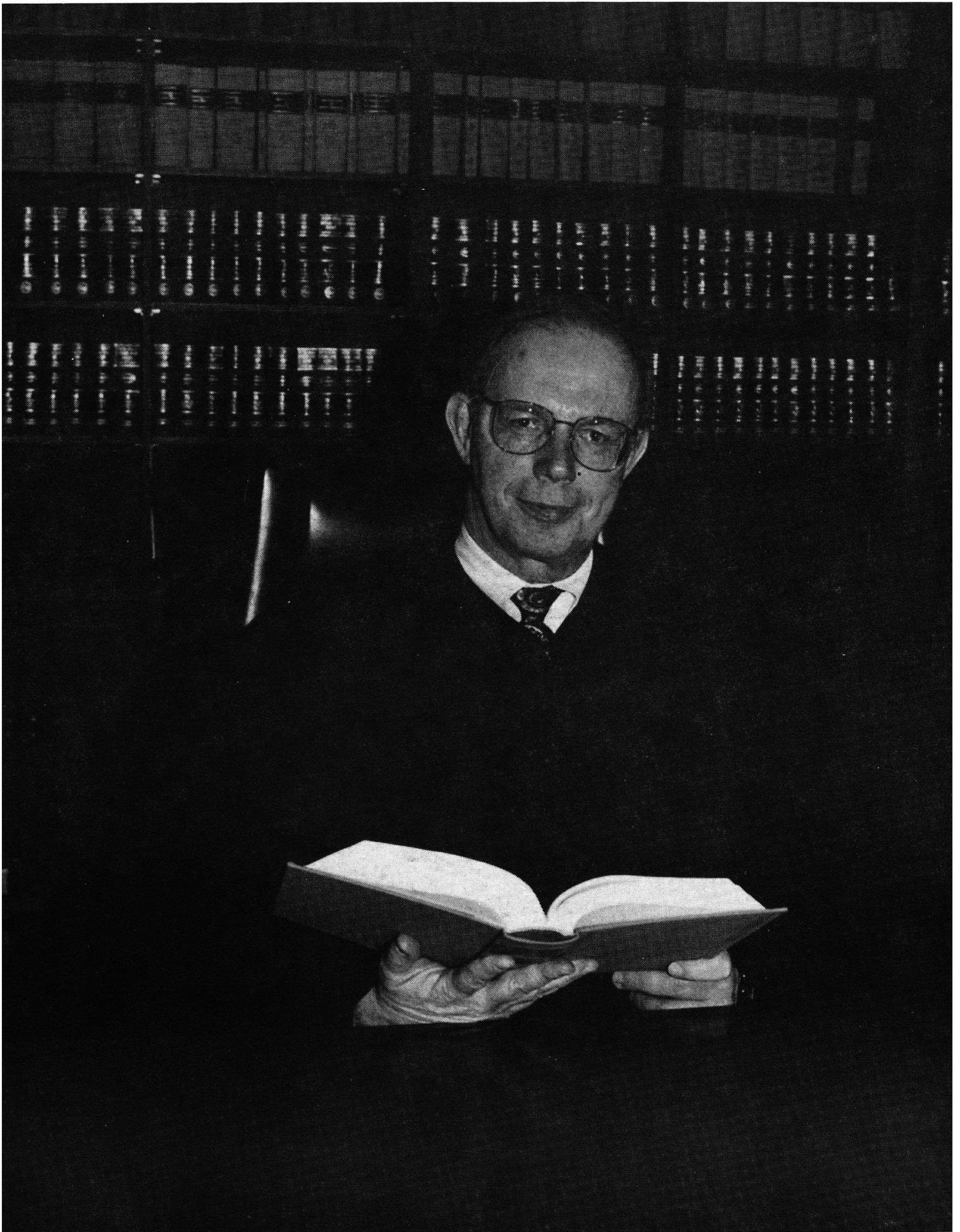

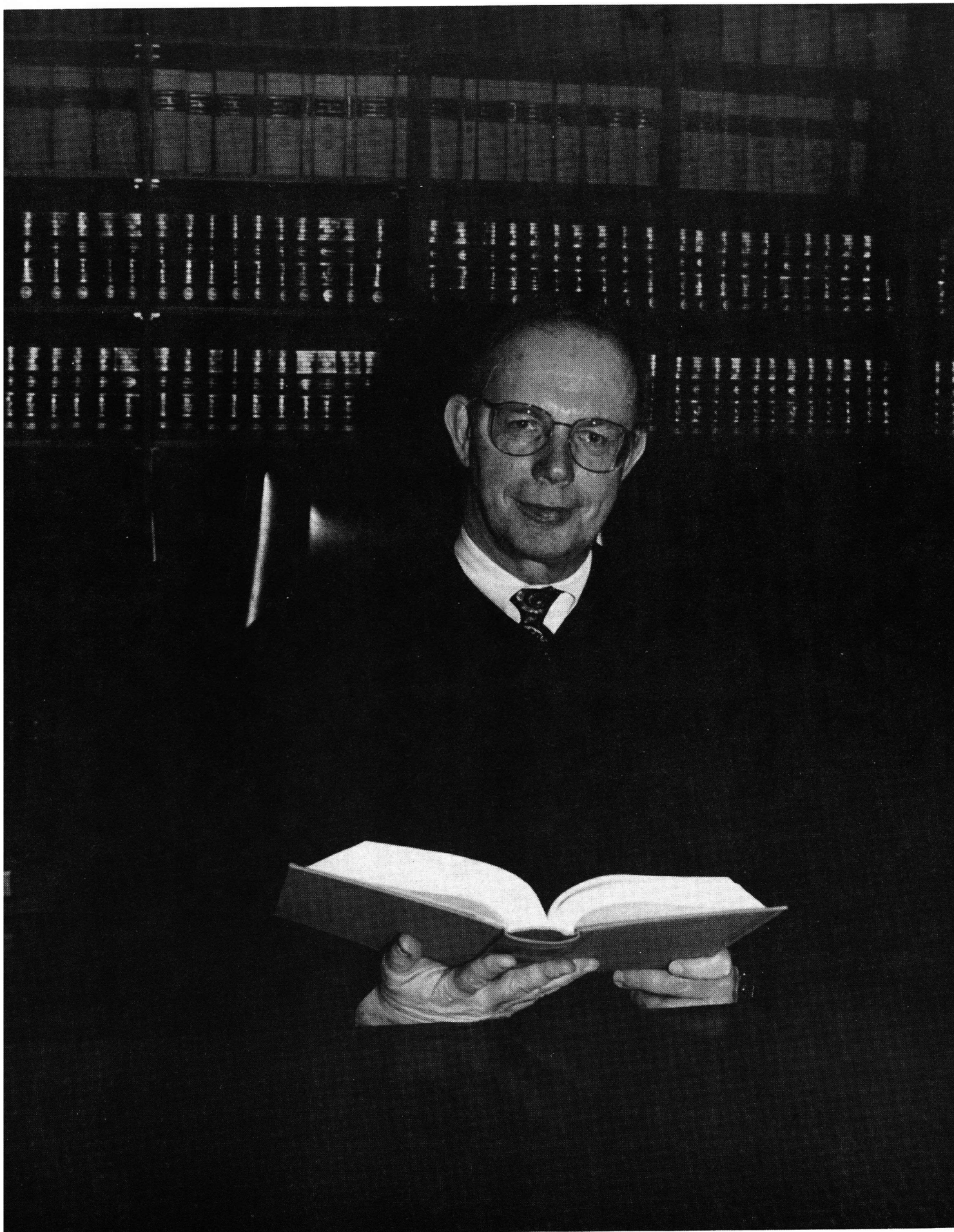

## **Chief Justice Burley B. Mitchell, Jr. North Carolina Supreme Court**



Burley B. Mitchell, Jr. was sworn in as the 24th Chief Justice of the North Carolina Supreme Court in January, 1995, promising to continue the Court's "great history of protecting rights."

A Raleigh native, Mitchell graduated from North Carolina State University cum laude and the University of North Carolina School of Law, after serving in the US Navy from 1958 to 1962 as a member of the 7th Fleet, Asia. Mitchell is a graduate of the Senior Appellate Judges Seminar, New York University School of Law and the Institute of Judicial Administration. In December, 1995, he received an honorary degree, Doctor of Humane Letters from North Carolina State University.

His career in justice began in 1969 when he became an assistant general of North Carolina. He served as district attorney for the Tenth Judicial District (Raleigh) from 1972 to 1977, prior to being appointed to the North Carolina Court of Appeals where he served until 1979.

He was named secretary of the North Carolina Department of Crime Control and Public Safety in 1979 and served in that post until 1982 when he was appointed associate justice of the Supreme Court of North Carolina. He was elected to retain his seat on the Supreme Court in 1982 and reelected in 1984 and 1992. Mitchell was appointed and took office as Chief Justice on January 3, 1995. On November 5, 1996, he was elected to an eight-year term as Chief Justice.

His career of public service includes serving as chair of the Governor's Advisory Board on Prisons and Punishment; member and chair of the Governor's Crime Commission; member of the North Carolina Courts Commission; and, member of the North Carolina News Media Administration of Justice Board of Advisors.

He is a past recipient of numerous awards, including the Campbell University School of Law Federalist Society "Law and Order" award. Outstanding Young Man of the Year Award from the City of Raleigh; the Freedom Guard Award of Community, Religious and Governmental Activities from the North Carolina Jaycees; the National Guard Citizenship Award; the North Carolina State University Outstanding Alumnus Award; and, the University of North Carolina School of Law Outstanding Alumnus Award.

Chief Justice Mitchell is a lifelong member of Hayes Barton Methodist Church in Raleigh and has served as a Sunday School teacher, president of the United Methodist Men, Sunday school superintendent, and lay leader. He has been married to the former Mary Lou Willett of Raleigh for 33 years and has two children.
