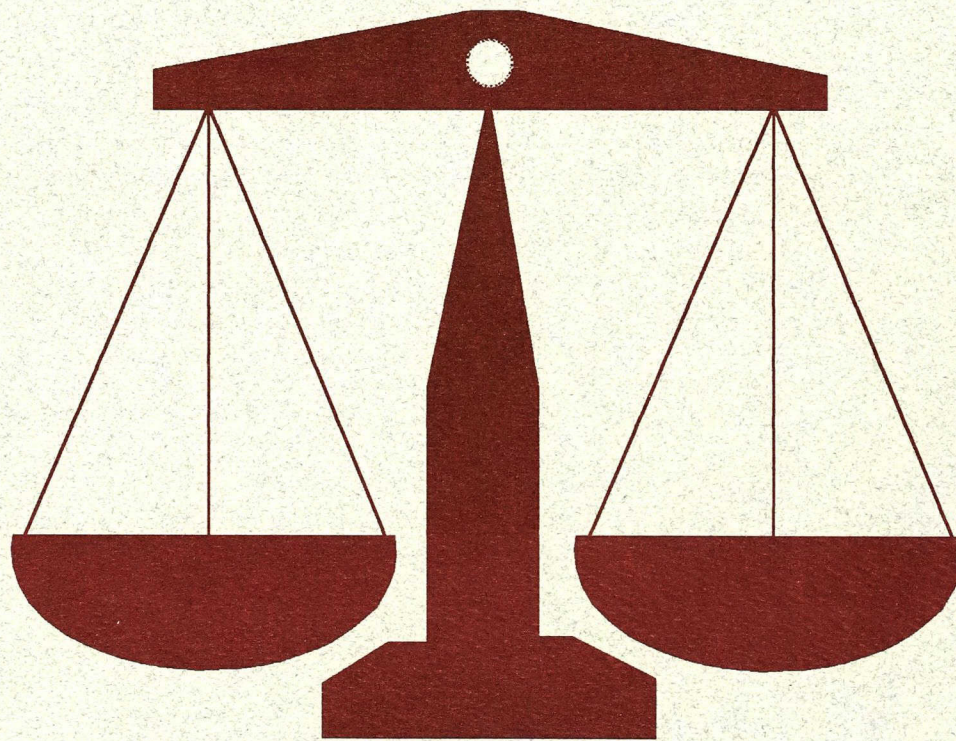

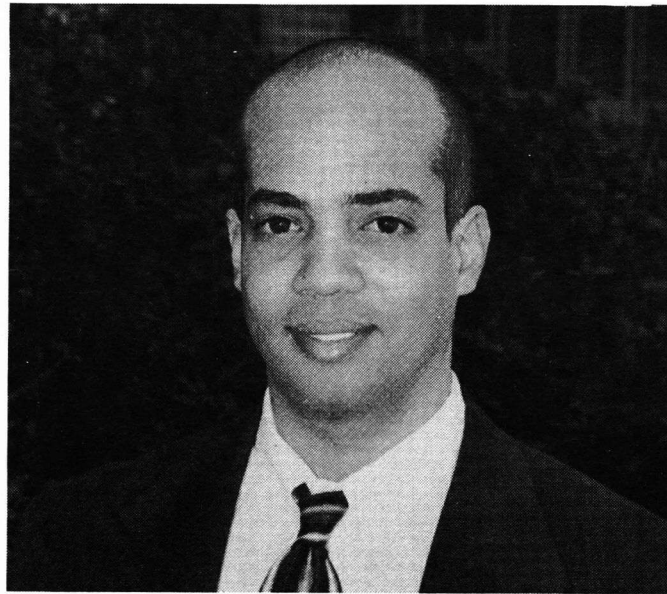

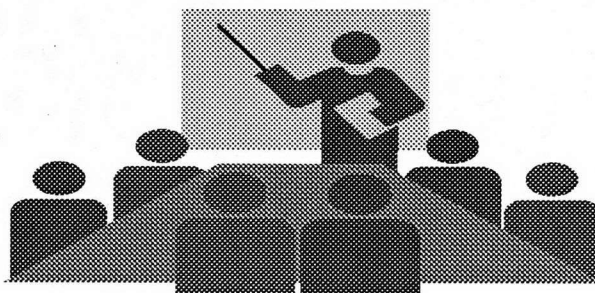


The Turner Law Building has been the location of the Law School since 1980
