MOOT COURT CANDIDATES ADVANCE TO FIRST SEAT IN SEMI-QUARTER FINALS

The Moot Court team candidates, Janet Brown, Angela Evans, Camela Green, Teresa Smallwood, Al Stewart, David Williams, and Ron Wright recently participated in the 1984 National Appellate Advocacy Competition hosted by Howard University School of Law. North Carolina Central's Moot Court candidates entered the competition with two teams, orally arguing against such teams as American University, Campbell University and the College of William and Mary.

The 1984 National topic presented several constitutional issues, ranging from a reporter asserting rights against divulging confidential sources to the issue of standing by a petitioner to assert a jus tertii claim on behalf of homosexuals in violation of a right to privacy claim.

Round 1 resulted in North Carolina Central's team being ranked as the "top seated" team out of the ten competing law schools. The success of the team assures the Law School family of the team's success with the next Appellate Advocacy competition.
