IMPORTANT FINANCIAL AID NOTICE: A recent change in federal regulations, beginning the Fall 1991 semester, requires that students attend classes for 30 days before a loan check can be issued. In addition, there will be no postponements or deferments for students whose tuition and fees are not paid by the deadline. **IT IS OF UTMOST IMPORTANCE THAT YOU SUBMIT YOUR FINANCIAL AID FORM (FAF) IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY DONE SO, AND THAT YOU MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO SECURE ALTERNATIVE FINANCIAL RESOURCES FOR TUITION AND FEES FOR THE INITIAL PHASE OF THE FALL SEMESTER.**

DEPARTMENT OF THE AIR FORCE: The Air Force Judge Advocate General's Department will be selecting approximately 20 attorneys as judge advocates between now and June 1991. Applications are also being accepted for positions available in 1992. The next selection board will be held at the Pentagon on June 11, 1991 to consider applications. U.S COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE NINTH CIRCUIT: This Court invites applications for the position of court law clerk with its central legal staff in San Francisco. Court law clerks work for the court as a whole, or for particular panels of judges, rather than for individual judges. Court law clerks research and write memoranda on cases and substantive motions and help panels draft dispositions in various areas of federal law. Approximately five positions will be available in September 1992. Interviews will be conducted from September through October 1991 and offers will be made by Thanksgiving 1991. Most appointments are for one year, but opportunities to remain beyond the first year frequently exist. The current entry level salary is \$33,605 and the second year salary is \$40,278 for those clerks who have been admitted to a state bar.
